



Course Registration Tips

Course Registration = Adding classes for next term

Enrollment Appointment = Student's time to register

Before Enrollment Appointment:

- Students should meet with their advisor
- Students must resolve holds on account

Students should register promptly on the day of their Enrollment Appointment

Registration for next term closes after grades post.



Verifying Classes During Drop/Add

Drop/Add period is for schedule adjustments

- Begins: A day or two before the semester starts (typically)
- Ends: 4th day of classes at 11:59pm
- Adding classes after 4th day is <u>NOT easy or guaranteed</u>

Mandatory first day attendance policy

- Students must be present the first day of <u>each</u> class or will be dropped by the instructor
- Students shouldn't count on first day drops for an unwanted course

Course Drop Options

7th Week Course Drop Deadline (prorated for summer terms)


- No refund unless approved for medical/mental health withdrawal
- Bright Futures students must repay funded portion of class

12th Week Course Drop Deadline (often 11th Week for Engineering)

- Typically requires academic dean's approval
- Limited number of late drops
- Same payment stipulations as above

Any Week of the Semester

Contact dean's office for crisis or medical/mental health reasons



Excess Hours Surcharge

Applies to credits beyond 120% of required degree hours

Most degrees are 120 hours so threshold = 144 hours

Does NOT Count	DOES Count
Accelerated credit (AP, IB, AICE)	Failed & repeated courses
HS dual enrollment	Dropped courses (after drop/add)
Dual degree or 2 nd major (if completed)	Unnecessary credits earned due to <u>late</u> major changes

Help for students:

Adjust schedule after Orientation.

Students may change their schedule until the window closes.

Submit Official Transcripts



Transfer Credit

- Transfer credit will be evaluated, then posted to transcript
- Applied to CoreFSU and major requirements if applicable
- Transfer credits post w/ letter grade

After Orientation



Action Needed!

- Send <u>final official</u> college transcripts for all previous coursework
- Make sure AA degree & Civic Literacy assessment completion are both listed on transcript

Students should check once the semester starts to ensure credits have been applied



Consider Delegated Access for Family

After Orientation

Students cannot share their FSU login!

Share My Information:

- Grants others access to view a student's class schedule, grades, financials, etc.
- Prompts family to create their own login & PIN.
- Allows students to grant or withdraw access at any time.
