

University Excused Absences Require Documentation (make up test / avoid absence grade penalty)

- Illness
- Death in the family or other documented crisis
- Call to active military duty or jury duty
- Religious holy days
- Official University activities (letter for instructor provided by FSU certifying office)

- Until formally admitted to major/upper-division

## Dean's Office in College for Admitted Major

- First-time freshmen admitted direct to BFA major
- Transfer admits with AA degree earned



# Track Degree & Major Requirements

#### 120 credits in most bachelor's degrees


- Liberal Studies: 36 hours general education (GE) + other graduation requirements
- Major requirements
- Everyone must choose some electives for major & Liberal Studies (pick interesting ones!)

#### Liberal Studies = foundation for major & degree

- Math, English, Science, History, Social Science, Humanities
- Skills: Computation, Writing, Critical Thinking, Speaking
- Lots of choices!








# Use Advising Technology & Info

FSU Academic Honor Policy Requires Students to Keep FSU Login & Password Confidential — should not be shared with anyone! (students may give family members Delegated Access)



Student Central: detailed access to academic & financial information

- Unofficial Transcript: download PDF version at any time
- Academic Requirements Report: online unofficial degree audit



Campus Connect: academic advising notes, appointment scheduling, & more



FSU Email: students should check daily for critical communications!



Canvas: learning management system for FSU courses



# Set Up Delegated Access for Family

Students <u>cannot share their FSU login</u> but can give delegated access to family:

- Allows others to view schedule, grades, transcript, financials, personal info

# Be Ready for Advising Tomorrow

#### Meeting tomorrow with academic advisor for CURRENT MAJOR!

- If major change needed before tomorrow, go to Concourse
   Level today from 3:15pm 4:15pm
- Review Engage 100: <a href="https://engage100.fsu.edu/">https://engage100.fsu.edu/</a>
- Resolve any holds on registration for missing info

#### Students register after advising (if no holds)

May adjust schedule over time till window closes



# **Ensure Accelerated Credit is Applied**

#### Accelerated credit from HS will count toward the degree!

- Applied to GE if applicable or the major if appropriate
- Course equivalency charts for test credit are in IAA or on the FSU Admissions website
- Test credits post to transcript with no grade / DE credits post with letter grade

#### Action needed!

- Send final transcripts ASAP for HS <u>and</u> dual enrollment/transfer coursework!
- Check Academic Requirements Report in September to ensure credits have been applied!

## Take a Full Credit Load to Reach Goals

- Fall and Spring: Take 15!
  - Most courses are 3 credit hours
  - Ideal = 14-16 credit hours
- Summer B Admits: 6-7 credits (6-week term)
  - 1st term should include at least 2 courses for best start to FSU GPA!
  - Must take classes in Summer B to meet conditions of admission



# Register Promptly & Before Finals!

Know Assigned Registration Appointment (each Fall & Spring)

- https://registrar.fsu.edu/registration\_guide/
- Resolve any registration holds to be ready
- Registration for <u>next term</u> closes when finals begin

Enrollment Appointment = Time to Register!

Drop/Add = Course Adjustments Only

Late Fee for waiting to register until Drop/Add week



# Verify Classes During Drop/Add Week

## Saturday before classes start to 4<sup>th</sup> day of classes

- Closes at 11:59pm verify schedule!
- Adding classes after 4<sup>th</sup> day is <u>NOT easy or guaranteed</u>

### First day non-attendance drops

- Student must be present or will be dropped by instructor
- Don't count on admin drop for unwanted course check!



## Monitor Grades & Know Course Drop Options

Some scholarships impact eligibility for course drops – see advisor!

#### 7<sup>th</sup> Week Course Drop Deadline (prorated for summer terms)

- Some may be able to drop courses by Friday of 7<sup>th</sup> week
- No course refund unless approved for medical/mental health withdrawal
- State law requires Bright Futures students to repay funded portion of class

#### 12<sup>th</sup> Week Course Drop Deadline (11<sup>th</sup> Week for Engineering)

- Some may be approved by the dean for late drop by Friday of 12<sup>th</sup> week
- Same payment stipulations as above

#### Any Week of the Semester

Contact dean's office for student crisis or medical/mental health withdrawal



# Be Aware of Excess Hours Surcharge

On credits beyond 120% of required degree hours

Most degrees are 120 hours so threshold = 144 hours

<b>Does NOT Count</b>	DOES Count
Acceleration Credit (AP, IB, AICE)	Failed & Repeated Courses
HS Dual Enrollment	Dropped Courses (after Drop/Add)
Second Major	Unnecessary Credits from LATE Major Changes

# Expect Grades @ FSU to be Different

4.0 Scale with +/- (no weighted classes like in HS)

A=4.0 / B=3.0 / C=2.0 / D=1.0 / F=0.0 +/- =0.25 up or down (no A+ in GPA)

Good academic standing = 2.0 + FSU GPA (not overall GPA)

Overall GPA is used for Bright Futures and admission to major First Fall term 0.0 = sit out spring semester (unless there was a crisis)

No grade replacement or "forgiveness" policy @ FSU!
